
KEY HIGHLIGHTS

FISHERS ARE ANGELSHARK STEWARDS

- 9 fishers met directly to introduce project.
- Best handling and information leaflets produced.
- Project information and leaflets distributed to fisher associations and charter fishers.

STATUS AND ECOLOGY OF ANGELSHARKS UNDERSTOOD

- 5 Angelsharks reported by fishers caught in 2018.
- 2 historic Angelshark records submitted.
- Angelshark washed up dead on Saundersfoot beach and collected for dissection.
- 12 historic illustrations of Angelshark sourced from online archives from books dating back to 1506.

SHARING INFORMATION ACROSS THE GENERATIONS

- Web and social media reached 1,443,852 people.
- Attended two events (Royal Welsh Show & Living Seas Wales event in Aberdyfi).
- 31 divers & 9 snorkelers signed up to Dive For Angels events (cancelled due to poor conditions).
